This term we will be developing our food preparation skills and making 2 recipes. We will grate, chop and peel ingredients to make a couscous salad and pretzels.




Art

Computing– Coding continued


The coding process includes design, algorithm, code, run and test then debug. Different code blocks can be stacked:



Maths

In Maths, we will consolidate our place value knowledge to 50. We can partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. Understanding the value of each digit allows us to compare and order numbers. We will use our number rhymes to ensure we form and orientate our numbers correctly.

Later we will revisit our addition and subtraction knowledge. We will think about which strategy and resources we could use.



Across this half term, we will be continuing to revisit our work on addition and subtraction. As well as multiplication and division for Year 2.

English

We are excited to read myths and legends from across the world and use our most descriptive language to retell the most interesting part!



In 'Ride of Passage' we will describe the characters and use our inference skills to think about how they might be feeling at different plot points.


Later in the term we will learn the story of Maui and the Giant Ika, practicing our character description and retell skills.
