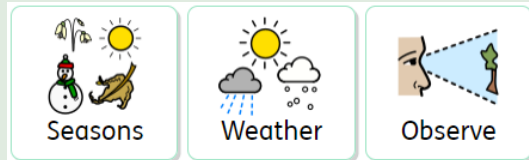

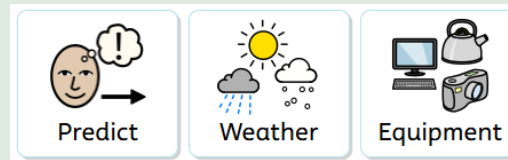

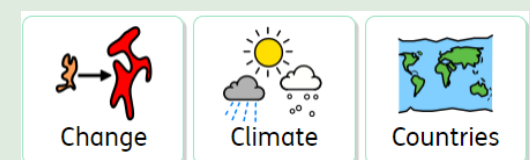

Music

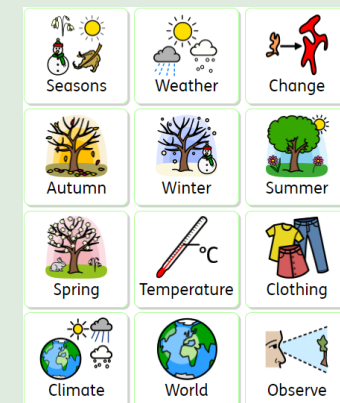
Through out the term we will be singing and performing

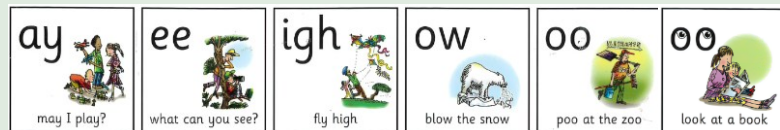




Phonics

We will be continuing to practice our blending skills and fluency through ditties, red books and green books.

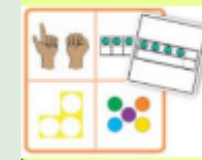

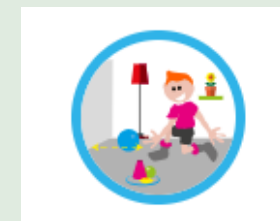
Reading

This term we will be revising set 2 sounds and introducing set 3 and using these in our spelling when writing. We will be reading real and non-sense words ready for the screening check in June.

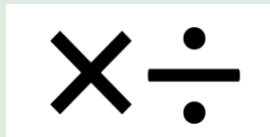

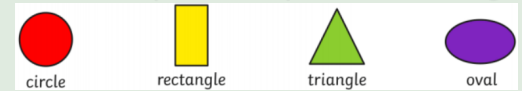

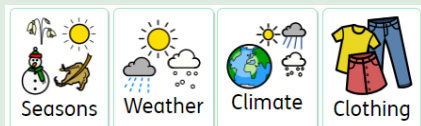
2D Shapes and Spatial Reasoning



History/Geography

In History we will be learning about different seasons and how seasons are different all over the world. We will be exploring how the weather and climate has changed over time and how clothing has changed over time reflecting the different seasons.

In Geography we will understand the different seasons and what they look like. We will explore what seasons look like in different countries and how the local environment changes too. Towards the end of the term, we will find out how scientists can predict the weather and the equipment they use.



Year 1

English

We will be using our phonics knowledge to spell CVC words and write captions and short sentences. Using colourful semantics we will begin to structure write and punctuate sentences. We will also be learning about predictions, character descriptions and non-fiction texts.



Science

In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats. Through this topic we will be nature spotting on the school grounds, identifying the things needed in a habitat for survival and investigating micro-habitats.
