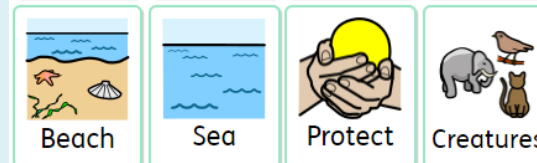

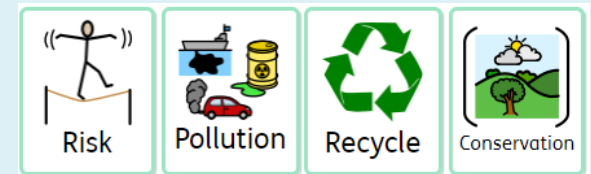

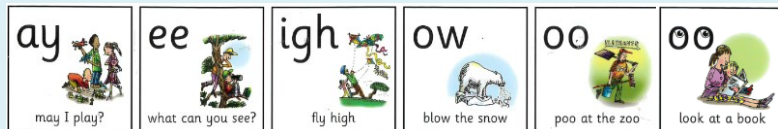




Phonics

We will be continuing to practice our blending skills and fluency through reading.



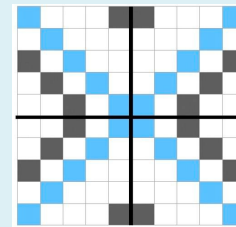

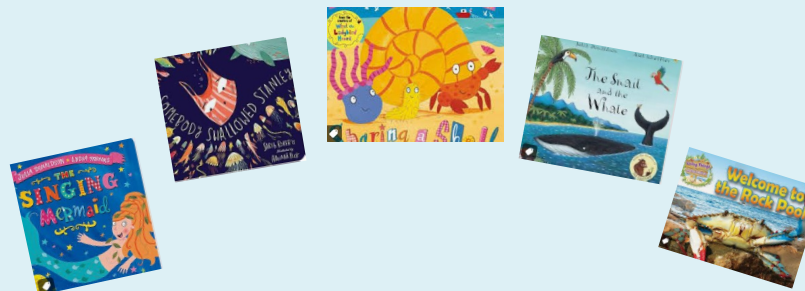
'Changing Me'

This term we will be revising set 2 sounds and introducing set 3 and using these in our spelling when writing. We will be reading real and non-sense words ready for the screening check in June.

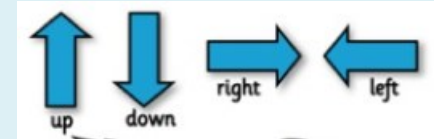

History/Geography

In History we will be learning about D-day, what happened on D-day and who the Allied Nations were. Towards the last week of the term, we will be reflecting on our year at school, our memories and our hopes and dreams for the future.

Year 1

English

We will be using our phonics knowledge to spell CVC words and write captions and short sentences. Using colourful semantics we will begin to structure write and punctuate sentences. We will also be writing factual sentences, joining phrases and sentence openers.



Science

In Science we will be continuing to learn about living things and their habitats. Linking into topic, we will be closely looking at animals and their habitats within the ocean. We will compare these habitats to woodland habitats.
